General Information

Entry Fee

- \$125 per team.
- Team registration and entry fee are due by or on **Sunday, January 28, 2018** in order to confirm your tentative registration (if applicable). Failure to do so can result in forfeiture of tentative registration (if applicable) thus opening registration to the next team on the waiting list. If a forfeiture occurs, re-entry may only occur after being cycled through the respective waiting list.
- Please note: Withdrawals or “no shows” from or during the tournament after **Sunday, January 28, 2018** will result in forfeiture of your entry fee.
- Each team is guaranteed three games (with the exceptions below).
 - The tournament directors/committee members retain the right to change the game format in the case of bad weather, low signups, no-shows, and for any other unforeseen circumstances.
 - Violations of rules and regulations can result in said team not playing three (3) games and the refund policy will not apply in these circumstances.
 - Tournament directors/committee members retain the right to adjust the tournament in any manner, at any time, on a case by case basis to adjust for any unforeseen circumstances.

Trophies/Awards

- Team awards will be awarded for first (1st), second (2nd), and third (3rd) place.

Insurance

- Each player and coach in this tournament shall be covered by his/her own medical insurance and must agree to the liability statement in the registration.

Officials

- OHSAA officials/referees will be used and assigned by an independent assignor for all games.
- In the event of an official/referee not appearing for a scheduled game, the gym supervisor or tournament director will assign a replacement.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. OHSAA rules will be followed except where specifically noted. Tournament directors/committee members retain the right to amend the rules and regulations at any time. Decisions made by the tournament directors/committee members shall be final.

2. **Rosters**
 - A. No more than two (2) coaches are permitted to be listed on the roster and seated in and/or around the bench area. Only one (1) coach at a time may stand during the game play.
 - B. Teams are limited to a maximum of twelve (12) players.
 - Players must attend the same school or be in the same district.
 - Players may not be added to the roster after the start of the team's first (1st) game.
 - Players can only play for one team in the tournament.
 - A team must have five (5) rostered players on the floor with a rostered coach before a game can begin.
 - No more than two (2) coaches are allowed on the roster/bench at any given time.
 - Only one (1) coach can stand at any time during game play.

3. **Uniforms**
 - A. All team members should have matching shirts with a clearly visible number on the front and/or back of the jersey.

4. **Scorebook/Scorer's table**
 - A. Each team is required to have a scorer (bookkeeper) at the scorer's table.
 - B. Scorers will not be permitted to sit or stand in the team's bench area.
 - C. Scorebooks will not leave the scorer's table once the game has started.
 - D. Scoresheets will be provided in the event you do not have a scorebook.
 - E. First/top team listed on the bracket for a particular game will be the HOME team and will be the official book for that game.

5. Arrival Times

- A. Teams should report to the designated gym a minimum of fifteen (15) minutes prior to the start of their game time.
- B. Games will start on time.
- C. If your opponent is prepared to start on time and you are five (5) or more minutes late in having five (5) rostered players on the court with a rostered coach to begin the game, you will forfeit that game.
- D. Weather related delays need to be communicated to the tournament director/committee.

6. Games will consist of two (2) – twenty (20) minute halves with a running clock.

7. Warm-ups will last for 5 minutes. Halftimes will last for 5 minutes.

8. Clock Operation

- A. The clock will stop during the game for the following reasons:
 - Timeouts.
 - On the referee's whistle during the last two (2) minutes of the second half with the exception listed below.
 - Injuries.
 - When requested by game officials, tournament directors, gym supervisors, or the scorer's table.
 - The clock operator's time is official and final in conjunction with referee direction/discretion.
- B. Clock stoppage exception
 - If a team is ahead by fifteen (15) or more points in the second half of said game, the clock will continue to run at all times with the exception of a called timeout or an official timeout.
 - This exception applies to the last two (2) minutes of the game.

9. Overtime

- A. Tie games will result in overtime.

- B. Repeated three (3) minute periods will be played until a winner is declared.
- C. Each team will receive one (1) timeout in each overtime period.
- D. No time outs will be carried forward from regulation or previous overtime periods.
- E. First minute of overtime is a running clock as described above. The clock will stop on the referee's whistle for the remaining two (2) minutes.

10. Free Throws

- A. The free throw line will be regulation fifteen (15) feet in length from the rim for fifth (5th) and sixth (6th) grade divisions.
- B. The free throw line will be shortened to twelve (12) feet in length from the rim for the fourth (4th) grade divisions.
- C. Rim height will remain at normal regulation height for all divisions.

11. Fouls

- A. Individual Fouls
 - Individual players will allowed a maximum of five (5) personal fouls per game.
 - Once a player commits his/her fifth (5th) personal foul in a particular game, he/she must be removed from the game and is unable to play for the remainder of that game (including any overtime periods in that game).
- B. Team Fouls
 - Cumulative teams fouls will be tabulated each half.
 - On the seventh (7th) team foul in said half, the opposing team will shoot a one (1)-and-one (1) free throw(s) (bonus).
 - On the tenth (10th) team foul in said half, the opposing team will shoot two (2) shot free throws (double bonus).
 - Team fouls committed in the second half will carry forward to any overtime periods.
 - The scorer's table tabulation of all fouls is final and official.
 - Technical fouls levied against an individual player shall count as a personal foul against the player and be added to the team foul tabulation for said half.
 - Technical fouls called on the bench/coaches will be added to the team foul tabulation.
 - All coaches lose standing rights for the rest of the game if any said coach has a technical foul levied against them personally.
 - Coaches that receive two (2) technical fouls in a particular game will be ejected from the game and the gym for the remainder of said game and are subject to the rules listed in the "Bench/Spectator Conduct"

- Players that receive two (2) technical fouls and/or are ejected from the game must remain seated on the bench for the remainder of the game. The player will not be permitted to play in the remainder of said game and will be suspended from playing in their team's next scheduled game.

12. Timeouts

- A. Each team will receive three (3) – one (1) minute time outs per game.
 - Timeouts will not carry over into any overtime period.
- B. Each team will receive one (1) – one (1) minute timeout per overtime period.
 - Timeouts will not carry over from one overtime period to the next.
- C. The scorer's table will be responsible for recording any used timeouts and maintaining a count of remaining timeouts.

13. Defense

- A. Full court pressing may be utilized in all divisions
- B. Once a team is ahead by ten (10) points, that team may not utilize a full court press.
 - Teams restricted from utilizing a full court press due to the ten (10) point rule can begin guarding the offensive players at half court.
 - The first violation of this rule will result in a warning.
 - The second and subsequent violations can result in a technical foul.

14. Bench/Spectator Conduct

- A. Only members of the team and coaching staff (maximum of two (2)) shall be on the bench during game play.
- B. Scorekeepers are prohibited from sitting, standing, or otherwise being present at the bench.
 - Violation of this rule may result in forfeiture of the game.
- C. Coaches, parents, and players are expected to behave in a manner that adheres to the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) standards.
 - Violations of these standards and technical fouls can result in the removal from the building at the discretion of the referees, tournaments directors, gym supervisor, and/or tournament committee.
 - o Players that receive two (2) technical fouls and/or are ejected from the game must remain seated on the bench for the remainder of the game. The player will not be permitted to play in the remainder of said game and will be suspended from playing in their team's next scheduled game.

- o Coaches or spectators that fail to leave the building within 2 (two) minutes after an ejection will result in the forfeiture of said game and continued resistance will result in the involvement of law enforcement.
- o Coaches will not be permitted to coach the remainder of the day of their ejection. Furthermore, entry will not be permitted into any of the tournament buildings for the remainder of the day of the ejection.
- o Spectators ejected from a building will be not be permitted entry into any of the tournament buildings for the remainder of the day the ejection takes place and no refund for admission will be allowed.
- o Tournament directors/committee members retain the right to exclude coaches, spectators, or players from the remainder of the tournament on a case by case basis if warranted.

15. Cancellations

A. In the event of inclement weather, the following procedure will be followed:

- Tournament committee members will contact team coaches only in the event of a cancellation.
- If you need quicker information on a weather decision, please have a team representative contact Gray Hagy (740-605-0015) or J.C. Schaumleffel (740-621-3110).
- If two (2) games are played by each team in the tourney, the tournament will considered complete.
- If your team completes two (2) games prior to a tournament cancellation, no team entry refund will occur.
- If only one (1) game has been played by a particular team, that team will be refunded 50% of the team entry fee.
- In the event that a team does not play any games, a full refund of the team entry fee will be allowed.
- Tournament directors/committee members retain the right to adjust the tournament in any manner, at any time, on a case by case basis to adjust for any unforeseen circumstances.
- No refunds will be made for admissions.
